Julie knows every child by name and genuinely cares about their well-being. Her ability to remember details about people's lives allows her to ask sincere questions. If she senses some hesitation or distress upon arrival, she finds a way to quickly neutralize it – usually with a compliment or relevant life question. More often than not, it works!



As a parent, I am extremely comforted knowing that my children are in good hands while away from them. The preschool program is built on over 50 years of experience with a collaboration of teachers and aides, many of whom used the program for their own young families.
